In a space no bigger than your Mum's linen cupboard, you can pick up a puck of deep-fried goodness that will take you straight back to childhood.

Though the doughnuts are not made on site, they are definitely fresh, churned out daily at nearby Chester Street Bakery in their hundreds, but available only at the Doughnut Time premises. All the doughnuts are of the classic, light and fluffy, yeasted variety and, like the famous peanut butter, they are never oily and never dry.

The best-selling Love at First Bite is a no-brainer, an original doughnut absolutely pumped full of Nutella. But we urge you towards the Crème de la Crème, a sugar-tossed round of dough, full of vanilla custard and with a hard-crack shell of caramel on top.

Drop in early on the weekend because they sell out fast, and if you're going for the full blowout don't forget to pick up a Peanut Butter Cup milkshake while you're there too. There's no seating, so you're sure to walk it off in no time.
